

## Terms and Conditions

- 1) General Remarks
  - a) The existing terms and conditions apply for the respective festival as entered on the homepage (mimf.at).
- 2) Duration of contract
- 3) The duration of contract is determined by the respective booked workshop times.
- 4) Workshop times
  - a. Instruction will take place according to the times given for the respective course on the MIMF homepage, unless otherwise noted. The dates and times are determined by the specifications in the application, that is, those alternate dates offered by MIMF and accepted in written form by the participant.
- 5) Class hours not attended by the participant will not be made up.
- 6) Fees
  - a. The registration fee of 20 Euros is to be understood as a processing fee for administrative expenditures for MIMF. This will be collected at the beginning of the workshop.
- 7) Rights and Obligations of MIMF
  - a. MIMF will provide the necessary infrastructure for the relevant workshop.
  - b. All materials will be provided by MIMF at no extra cost.
  - c. MIMF will take no responsibility for a guarantee of success for any educational objectives and will grant no guarantee for success or career expectations after the completion of the respective course.
  - d. If a participant does not or only partially attends the workshop, he/she is still obligated to pay the registration fee and is not entitled to a refund of fees already paid.
  - e. The participant is liable for any damages incurred by him/her or his/her accompanying persons to instruments or operating devices.
  - f. It is not permitted to copy instruction material, as intellectual property rights are associated with this. MIMF reserves the right to take legal measures if an infringement of this occurs. All instruction materials placed at the participants' disposal are governed by intellectual property rights and thus are protected by law.
  - g. The participant is obliged to provide to MIMF per email at office@mimf.at changes in data given in the online application (i.e. home address, email address, telephone, etc.) for the duration of a course.
  - h. As MIMF is committed to sustainability and to the use of environmentally friendly resources, the participants are requested to use public transportation, that is, to carpool if possible. As MIMF is committed to connecting and unifying people in order to break down social, cultural and religious barriers, MIMF reserves the right to exclude without explanation any participants from MIMF or from workshops when behaviors occur that foment fanaticism, racism, hate or violence against groups or individuals or foment



discrimination based on culture, race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age.

8) Cancellation

- a. The application fee will not be refunded after the workshop has begun.
- b. There will be no fee for an early cancellation.

9) Dispute resolution

- a. Dispute resolution and place of jurisdiction for all claims concerning these terms and conditions is Murau.

10) Subsidiary agreements

- a. Amendments and modifications to these terms and conditions must be in written form.

11) Copyrights

- a. The participant confers on MIMF the complete usufructuary and exploitation rights for pictorial, video and audio as well as film material that ensue during the MIMF workshops, concerts and all other events.
- b. It is not permitted for a participant to record or release pictorial, video and audio as well as film material.

12) Acts of Nature

- a. In case of an act of nature MIMF is obliged to inform the participant of its occurrence immediately. In this case, MIMF and the participant are entitled to withdraw from these terms and conditions, whereby MIMF reserves the right to claim the registration fee depending on the time of occurrence of the incident.
- b. As an act of nature, those incidents qualify that verifiably and through no one's fault prevent, decisively impair or make impossible MIMF and its workshops from being carried out.

13) Liability

- a. Participation at MIMF and its workshops takes place at one's own risk. Each participant is responsible for being in adequate physical condition and in command of his/her faculties necessary for the respective activity and participates with the appropriate attire in the corresponding event.
- b. MIMF plans, organizes and accompanies the workshops and therefore cannot assume liability resulting from these activities.
- c. MIMF is only liable for verifiable behavior due to deliberate intent and gross negligence. Thus liability for slight negligence is decidedly precluded.
- d. MIMF is especially not liable for the behavior of other participants as well as any third parties.
